

### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- Every class herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF and MHSA Rule Books and will be judged in accordance therewith. Zone III specifications are at www.usef. org/documents/zones/2017ZoneSpecs.pdf
- The management reserves the right to decline to receive any entry, or to return any entry fees before or during the show, without being liable for damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to Judges or officials on the part of the owner, rider, trainer or groom shall disqualify the entry and the owner shall forfeit entry and other fees. See Rule GR914.
- Post Entries will be accepted if time and space permits for a late fee of \$35. Closing date for each show will be: Showplace Spring Festival - March 20, 2017 Maryland National Horse Show - March 27, 2017
- 4. Entries must be made on the official show entry blank, and include all required information and signatures. All fees must be paid and entry completed before numbers can be issued. Membership and measurement cards, where applicable, must be presented. Horses/ponies not having current measurement cards will be measured at the show.
- Exhibitors shall be responsible for the entry fees of all horses entered by them or their agents even though the payment of those fees are not submitted with the entry blanks. There will be no refund of stabling fees.
- 6. All entries will be charged a \$35 office fee.
- Every horse entered will be charged a USEF Federation Fee of \$16 (\$8 D/M + \$8 USEF fee) and USHJA Fee of \$7.
- 8. Stall fees are not refundable.
- Scratch Fee Once the show has commenced, horses not shown in any and all classes entered forfeit their entry fees unless a receipt from the official Show Veterinarian is received, less a \$50.00 scratch fee/entry.
- 10. Non-Showing Horses A fee of \$100/entry/show will be charged for each non-showing horse. Horses must be registered on an entry form with the official show secretary and recorded with the Stable Manager. Non-Showing horses may be limited based on stall availability.
- 11. Temporary or permanent stalls with attached doors will be available at \$185 for the show. If available, \$100 for one day (arriving and leaving same day or \$150 for night (arriving after 4:00 p.m. and leaving next day). Initial bedding will not be provided. Shavings available at \$9.00 per bag. No refund on ordered stalls unless approved by Show Management.
- All accounts must be settled in full at the show. A fee of \$50
  or 10% whichever is greater will be charged for any returned
  checks.
- 13. Unpaid entries will be forwarded to USEF per Chapter 9, GR913.
- 14. In the event of cancellation of classes due to severe weather or other emergency, the competition will refund entry fees at the request of the exhibitor within 30 days of the cancellation.
- 15. Proof of a negative Coggins test taken within one year must accompany each entry. Please have your USEF Equine Vacinnation Record available to be viewed by office staff before you pick up your number(s).
- 16. Measurement Times will be posted in the Show Office.

- All riders must wear properly fastened USEF approved headgear at all times while mounted on the show grounds.
- All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration number from the USHJA.
- 19. Prize money will be paid in the show office by credit to the horse's account. Prize money in excess of entry fees will be paid to the owner of record by check within 30 days of the show. It is the sole responsibility of the competitor to provide the competition secretary with accurate payee information, including Social Security Number, Federal ID number or Tax Identification number, payee name and address.
- 20. The management, Belfield Farm Show Management, will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any exhibitor, owner, attendant, horse or equipment at the show.
- Eight ribbons will be awarded in all rated Hunter and Equitation classes unless specified otherwise.
- 22. Should any questions or disputes arise that are not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to the management whose decision shall be final.
- 23. Management may fine exhibitors up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.
- 24. Dogs must be kept on leashes at all times when on the show grounds. Fines will be imposed for damage or interference caused by your dog.
- 25. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s). and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- 26. Three entries are required to fill a performance class unless otherwise specified, or the class may declared void at the discretion of the committee. The committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes as deemed necessary.
- 27. Hunter championship and reserve champion will be awarded to 2 of the top 4 horses receiving the most points O/F. Only these 4 horses will receive full points in U/S classes, and ½ points in model classes towards the championship. All classes offered will be worth full points except model classes.
- 28. It is a condition of entry that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.

The TAKE2 Second Career Thoroughbred Program Inc. is committed to promoting and developing second careers for racehorses when they have retired from the track. Launched in 2012 by the New York Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association (NYTHA), in collaboration with the New York Racing Association (NYRA) and the New York Thoroughbred Breeders Inc. (NYTB), TAKE2 funds prize money and awards in hunter and jumper classes restricted to Thoroughbreds that are eligible to be registered with The Jockey Club. The program was offered at USEF-rated horse shows in New York, New Jersey (where it was sponsored by New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association) and Texas (where it was co-sponsored by The Paddock Foundation) in 2012. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. 




